Tournament Rules & Information

- This is a USA Hockey Sanctioned event; therefore all teams must be registered with USA Hockey. An official USA Hockey team roster must be sent with application and payment. No team will be allowed on the ice without a USA Hockey roster.
- All games will follow USA Hockey, 2001-2003 OFFICIAL RULES of ICE HOCKEY rules with the following modification: Any player or coach that is issued a game misconduct penalty will be removed immediately for the balance of the tournament. No exceptions.
- USA Hockey's "ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY" will be strictly enforced. Coaches, players, parents and fans will be required to adhere to this policy at all times.
- Two points will be issued to the winning team of each game for a win and one point to both teams if the game ends in a tie.
- The championship game will consist of the 2 teams with the most points and tiebreaking procedures are as follows:
 1. Most wins
 2. Head to head record
 3. Fewest total goals allowed
 4. Fewest goals allowed in third periods
 5. Team who scored earliest in their first game of the tournament
- Preliminary games may end in a tie. If the championship game ends in a tie after three periods, sudden death play will take place in the following format: "4 on 4" for 2 minutes, "3 on 3" for 2 minutes, "2 on 2" until a goal is scored.
- Teams should bring their Home and Away jerseys to the tournament.
- The tournament committee will decide on interpretation of all rules for tournament play.
- The schedule is not set at this time. Applications are accepted on a first come first serve basis, (including payment). Your check will be returned if there are no more available spots.
